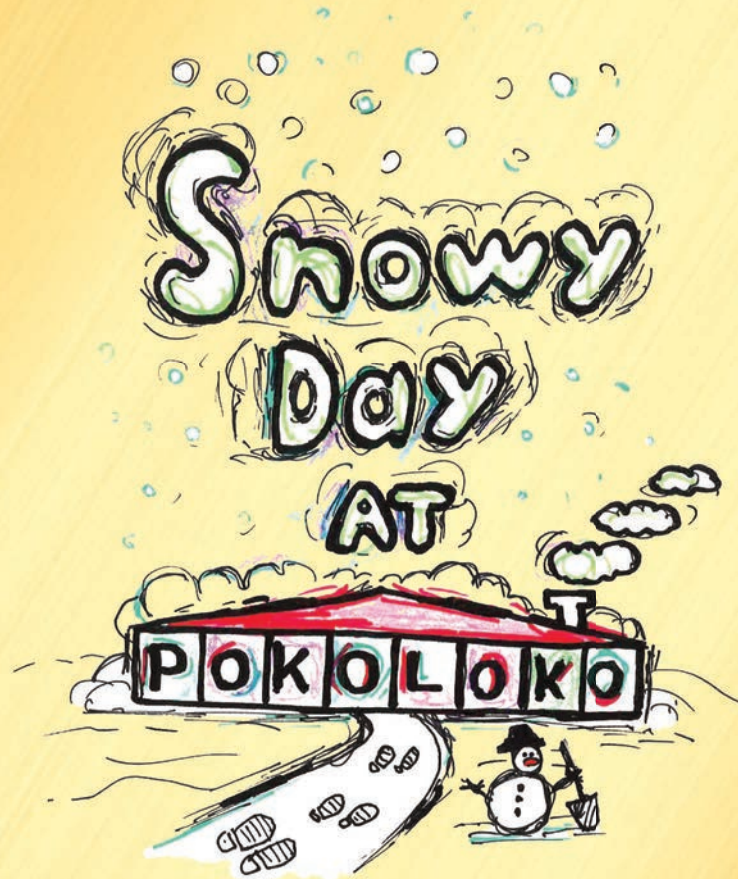
- We always try to play outside during the winter months — weather permitting.

Infants & Toddlers

- Both our Infant and Toddler centers have separate entrances and are always “SHOES OFF,” regardless of weather.

We do this to help keep our classrooms clean for your child.

- Please remove your shoes before entering classrooms.
- For your convenience, we offer blue booties if your shoes are not slip on/slip off.
- If your child walks from the outside into the Infant or Toddler Center, please remove their shoes as well.

These children should always keep a spare pair of indoor shoes at Poko Loko that they can wear at school.



Two-Year-Olds to Five-Year-Olds

Our Preschool has a separate entrance

- On DRY or SUNNY DAYS everyone is allowed to wear their outdoor shoes in the school classrooms.
- On SNOWY DAYS we ask that you follow these guidelines to help keep our classrooms clean for your child.



Parents

- Please stay on the GREEN CARPETS at the front of your child's classroom.
- If you want to go off the green carpet and enter your child's classroom, please remove your shoes beforehand.
- Blue booties are available for those hard to remove adult shoes.

Students

- Please help your child remove their shoes and leave them on the green carpet near their locker.
- Help your child change into their clean school shoes before they enter their classroom. A spare pair of indoor shoes should always be kept at Poko Loko for these wet and snowy days.
